

## 2009 Southern New Hampshire MABL By-Laws

### Executive Board:

President Matt Larochelle, co-treasurer/budget, baseballs, umpires, insurance.

Vice President James P. Makris, co-treasurer/\$ collector, league communications.

1. The League Board is responsible for running the league, and reserves the right to amend any rules as they see fit. A team can contact any Executive Board according to a team's concern.
2. This league will adhere to the rules and regulations of the nationally affiliated MABL rule book, including SNH MABL's amendments, by-laws, and team responsibilities.
3. Every team will receive a copy of all SNH MABL's documents containing the rule book, league By-laws, and team responsibilities, in which every representative needs to sign the "team contract", and every player needs to sign the participation contract and waiver and consent forms before the season starts.
4. Every team has one vote during a meeting. If a team is not represented during a vote, that team must forfeit its vote.
5. In the event of a tied vote, the Executive Board will vote independently to resolve the tie.
6. The draft order will follow the previous season's playoff seeding in reverse order of succession, with the lowest seed picking 1<sup>st</sup> and the champions picking last. The playoff runner-up will have the 2<sup>nd</sup> -to-last pick. Except for the Championship Series, playoff results do not have any bearing on the following season's draft.
7. Expansion teams entering the draft will have the last pick in the 1<sup>st</sup> round, then they have the 1<sup>st</sup> pick in the following rounds.
8. All undrafted players must clear waivers before signing with a team, which includes contacting the executive board before a player is signed.
